The first film of the season to be shown in the Village Hall at Clapton, on **Thursday, 7th September 2023**, will be **Tar**, (2022, USA, 152 mins) starring Cate Blanchett.

Lydia Tar is a groundbreaking conductor of a major German orchestra. We meet Tar at the height of her career, as she is preparing both a book launch and much-anticipated live performance of Mahler's Fifth Symphony. Over the ensuing weeks her life begins to unravel in a singularly modern way. The result is a searing examination of power, and its impact and durability in today's society.

Doors are **open at 7pm** and the **film starts at 7.30pm**, so there is plenty of time to meet with friends old and new. Tea/coffee/biscuits are available (50p). We also hold a raffle (£1).
