An introduction to the Jubilee Hall



The Jubilee Hall re-opened after extensive repair and renovation in January 2007. Comprising a Main Hall, Committee Room, and New Meeting Room, the building offers users a totally modern facility, while retaining the charm of a late Victorian building of distinction. It was a gift to the village by Lord Bridport in celebration of the Golden Jubilee of Queen Victoria's reign. The main hall has a beautiful vaulted timbered roof and a new oak strip floor with a modern hot water heating system encased in a wainscot. It has a 'state-of-the-art' lighting system incorporating three independently switched lighting systems, arranged in three sections. This provides considerable flexibility of use, to meet a very wide variety of requirements. There are a large number of power points, some flush mounted in the floor, based around a 3 Phase supply.

All the meeting rooms have Broadband with wireless access.

The building has modern, well-equipped toilet facilities. For the disabled, fully equipped toilet facilities are available on the same level as the main hall and the small meeting room. There is also assisted access for the disabled to the building by way of a short ramp adjacent to the main gate on Church Street. Lightweight portable ramps are available to assist access through the main gate and to and from the Committee Room from the Main Hall.



The committee room is accessed either through the Main Hall, or by its own door from the rear of the building. It is a recent addition that is suitable for many types of smaller events, but is often used in conjunction with the Main Hall.

The well-equipped kitchen can cater for meals cooked on the spot. It has a large oven, refrigerator, food warmer and a counter opening onto the Committee room. It is used frequently as a Bar



The Small Meeting Room is suitable for small meetings and with its small sink unit and electric kettle provides the facility for making hot drinks. The hall has Broadband facilities in each area.

An attractive small garden is available, which is easily accessible from the back of the hall.



The Main Hall is equipped with a modern, easy to use, public address system, which also incorporates an induction loop system for the hard of hearing. Two types of wireless microphones are available. A PC and Digital projector is available
