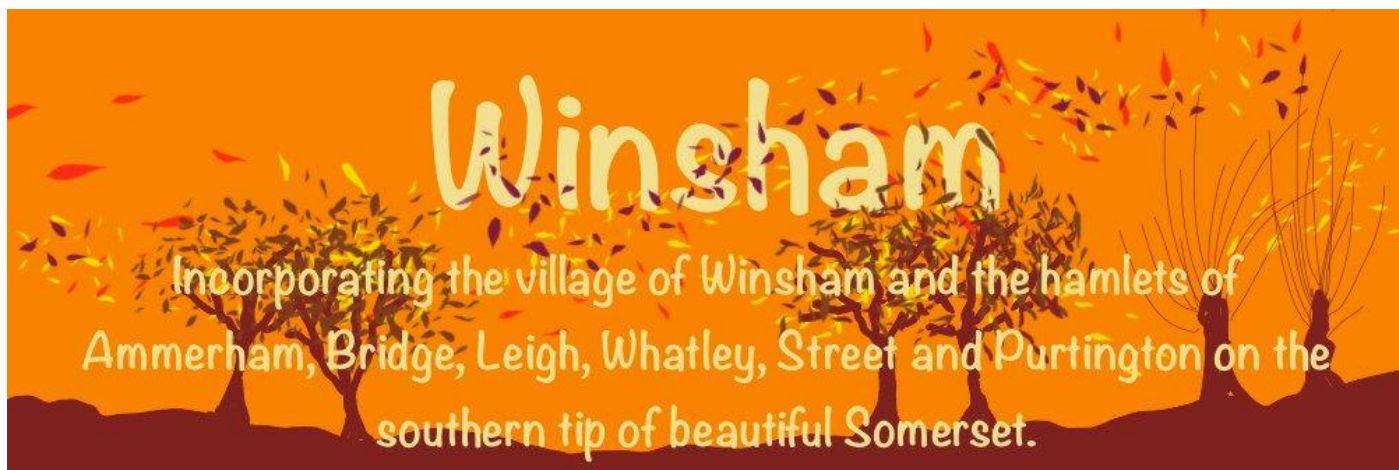




Winsham-in the county of Somerset

Meanwhile, the usual village events continue, and can be found by browsing the Parish Web site, on the Home page if they are not listed below, or on the Community Facebook page.

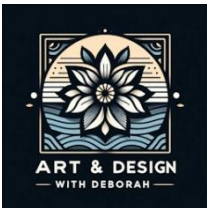
